“But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, ¹⁴ I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

¹⁵ Let those of us who are mature think this way” (Philippians 3:13b-14 ESV).

2. Look back with _____, and look forward with _____.

“And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose” (Romans 8:28 ESV).

“Faith is the substance (KJV) | confidence (NIV) | assurance (ESV) of things hoped for, the conviction (NASB) of things not seen” (Hebrew 11:1).

Substance/Confidence/Assurance: (Gr) hupostasis: literally, the hupo “underlying” stasis “reality” or “guarantee.” From an NT perspective we pray “from” Heaven not “for” it. There is no disease, poverty, or sin in Heaven.

Conviction: (Gr) elenchos: “proof” or “internal assurance.” Based on God’s word and promise we know of heaven’s existence. Through the renewing of our minds we arrive at a place of internal, confident belief in the invisible, hypostatic reality **BREAKING FORTH ON THE EARTH** by walking in faith with God.

3. Live in true _____.

“Whoever the Son sets free shall be free indeed” (John 8:36 ESV).

“I know that you can do all things, and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted” (Job 42:2 ESV).
